**November Thoughts – From Absence to Presence**: The session reminded me of something I'd heard from Ronald Rolheiser, the Canadian theologian. "My mum was not the easiest person to live with, he said, "But of all the people I have met, she was the most generous, and our house was always full of visitors." He went on: "so when I am generous, my mum is alive. When I am warm and welcoming, my mum is alive. When I ask myself what my mum would do, she is alive. When I miss her, she is alive." There is a spiritual wisdom in being able to be reunited like this. There was no doubt that, as the group continued to reflect on people they lost, they were reunited with them, not in some spiritualist sense, but in a rich and deep vein.
