Tom Gunning Nature's Way – A Guide to Green Therapy (Beehive Books)

The brain prefers nature sounds to man-made or mechanical sounds.

So when you go out into nature for some green therapy, it's best to go to places that are free from traffic, aviation or agricultural noise. The sounds of nature that we most like are water, wind and birdsong so pick the times when birdsong is at its loudest in your environment. When we go into nature and try to listen to its sounds it can be more difficult than appreciating its sights. As a general rule, try to avoid human sounds when renewing yourself in nature. Most of the demands in our lives come from other humans.
