Religion 'spreading like cancer' in North Korea: Reports from communist North Korea suggest that soldiers are adopting religion, and the government is stepping up programs to eradicate it. Religion is 'spreading like a cancer inside North Korea's armed forces, whose mission is to defend socialism; therefore it must be eradicated without delay since it comes from our enemies from around the world' reads a booklet prepared by the Propaganda department of the North Korean Army entitled 'Saving Our Soldiers From the Threat of Religion.' Although religion is ostensibly allowed in this society people who want to join a traditional religion, especially Buddhism and Christianity, must overcome numerous obstacles, such as joining Communist Party controlled organisations. Believers who do not join the government-sanctioned groups are persecuted, often brutally and violently. Anyone engaged in any kind of missionary activity receives similar treatment. *Asian News.ita as reported in NCR September 28, 2007.*
