Today's Gospel always evokes in me a sense of a sharing: a sense of family picnic. The Feast of Corpus Christi reminds us of our responsibility to be in communion with the whole body of Christ. There is room for everyone at the divine banquet – especially the poor and the hungry.

In today's Gospel story of the feeding of the five thousand, Jesus refuses to leave anyone hungry, even when his own disciples suggest sending the crowds away. There is more than enough bread for everyone.

Notice that Jesus gives the food to his disciples to distribute among the hungry crowd. He is passing on the responsibility to his followers. It is up to all of us to help those in need. Having received Jesus' body and blood in the Eucharist, we are expected to pass it on – to play our part in feeding the hungry and working for justice.

	This Week's Calendar of Feasts and Saints:
Tuesday 31 st May	- <i>The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary</i> The visit of the Mother of God, with the child Jesus in her womb, to her cousin Elizabeth, who was herself six months' pregnant with the forerunner of Christ, St. John the Baptist.
Wednesday 1 st Ju	Ine – St. Justin Martyr [100-165] An early Christian apologist, regarded as the foremost interpreter of the theory of the Logos in the 2 nd century. Was martyred, alongside some of his students.
Friday 3 rd June –	<i>Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus</i> Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back at least to the 11 th century, but through the 16 th century, it remained a private devotion, often tied to devotion to the Five Wounds of Christ.
Saturday 4 th June	Immaculate Heart of Jesus Often depicted in Christian art as a flaming heart shining with divine light, pierced by the lance-wound, encircled by the crown of thorns, surmounted by a cross, and bleeding. Sometimes the image is shown shining within the bosom of Christ with his wounded hands pointing at the heart. The wounds and crown of thorns allude to the manner of Jesus' death, while the fire represents the transformative power of divine love.
	<i>St. Kevin (abbot) [498-618]</i> Known as the founder and first abbot of Glendalough in County Wicklow, Ireland.
	<i>St. Charles Lwanga and Companions (martyrs)</i> Ugandans convert to the Catholic Church, who were martyred for their faith and are revered as saints by both the Catholic Church and the Anglican Communion.
Sunday 5 th June -	- <i>St. Boniface (bishop and martyr)</i> Anglo-Saxon missionary who propagated Christianity in the Frankish Empire during the 8 th century. Patron Saint of Germany, the first archbishop of Mainz and the "Apostle of the Germans". [NOT CELEBRATED THIS YEAR]
