elines on Use of Modern Technology when Working with Children: - Use of photography and video se of photography and video is an issue of great concern among those working with children. The Diocese nises that every parish has their own arrangements in relation to its use in schools, youth groups and for the ments however the guidelines have been devised below to aid parishes and diocesan groups:

- always good practice to seek written permission from a parent or guardian before taking any photographs or eo footage of children. This written permission must be sought from the parent/guardian or the person who ns the photograph before it can be displayed on promotional materials or websites. This can be incorporated the registration form when a child joins a group (template permission Resource 10);
- ither names nor any personal information should be displayed alongside any photographs;
- ecial consideration should be given where taking photographs or video footage might be misinterpreted, or the ages could be seen as provocative (e.g. beach trip or gymnastics display etc.). It is not to say, however, that h the right planning, these events cannot be recorded and enjoyed.
- otography and video recording are important methods of recording social activity and providing an historic ord – illustrating and validating important moments in people's lives. This process is a powerful and personal , and therefore we must respect the rights of all to make the choice whether or not to be photographed.

The man in the Gospel story today has had his sight restored. Notice how his sight grows more clearly throughout the account until he finally worships Jesus. We can be blind in many ways through our refusal to believe that we can contribute to positive change in the world. Too often we dismiss these realities by thinking we can do nothing about situations such as the global water crisis. This is blindness. We sometimes hide from the evidence before us and take refuge in prayer. Prayer is important but we must also be open to action. What we do, what we buy, how we use the plentiful resources at our disposal; these all affect the wider global community. Words attributed to Oscar Romero read: 'We cannot do everything and there is a sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something, and to do it very well.' How can we as parish communities work for justice for our brothers and sisters who are in need? We need to see them, to see their struggle, to see the systems which contribute to this crisis. This is one small way in which we can open our eyes and open the eyes of others. It is not simply about giving money. We must open our eyes. Today we pray that we can have our sight restored so that, like the man in the Gospel, we can truly worship Jesus.
